AND WHEREAS the Settler/Trustee hereby declare that the said funds and all further funds, donations and contributions in any shape or form to the said funds from time to time and the rents, profits and incomes thereof and the stocks, funds properties and securities for the time being representing the same shall be called Foundation/Trust Fund and held upon the trust for the objects and purpose and provisions hereinafter mentioned.

AND WHEREAS the Trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and all the provisions of this deed are to be constituted accordingly.

2. The Registered Office of the Foundation/Trust shall be 171 **Abhilasha, Eldeco Udyan-II, Raibareli Road, Lucknow** or at any other place or places in India that the Trustees may decide from time to time.
3. The objectives with which the Trust is formed are as under:
  - i. To promote love and passion regarding the organic farming and organic products among the public and strengthen this sector through provisions of financial relief. To promote farmers, entrepreneurs, professionals and market forces towards organic revolution which would ultimately strengthen the health of general public.
  - ii. To promote sustainable agricultural practices through organic inputs for social and environmental development for better human life on this earth.
  - iii. To bring all development professionals who are committed for the cause of organic revolution in the country under one network and support all these efforts in the country by financial and physical inputs.
  - iv. To provide aid, assistance, sponsorship, coordination or opening educational institutions / schools / colleges at all level for overall upliftment of society in urban / rural areas.
  - v. To hold lectures, seminars, workshops, study circles, exposure tours and training programmes for enhancing the knowledge and understanding of organic revolution in the country.

- xxix To create awareness and livelihood through food processing training and programmes in urban and rural people for generating employment through organic farming.

4. The management and control of the Foundation/Trust and properties shall vest in the name of Two Managing Trustees which are as follows:

- a) Mr. Avadhesh Kumar S/o Sri. S.D. Srivastava, 171 Abhilasha, Eldeco, Udyan-II, Raibarily Road, Lucknow, UP
- b) Smt. Shobha Asthana W/o D.P. Asthana, Society Park, Narahi, Lucknow, UP.

5. The Managing Trustees shall have full and unfettered power to regulate and manage the affairs of the Foundation. In order to fulfill the objects of the Foundation, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions, the Trustees shall have the following powers:

- i To accept donations, contributions, earnings by interest, grants and/or subscriptions, either in cash or in kind from any person, body and/or trust with or without conditions.

- vi To let out any immovable property comprised of the Foundation Fund for the period, rent rate or on such terms and conditions, as the Trustees may deem fit for furtherance of Foundation objectives
- vii To deposit off either by sale or by action any property comprising of the Foundation Fund.
- viii To adjust, settle compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all actions, suits claims demands and proceedings regarding the Foundation Fund.
- ix To make provisions, if need be for appointment of a person (including any of the trustees or otherwise) for managing or facilitating the foundation operations.
- x To prepare, vary, alter or modify the schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Foundation.
- xi To set apart and/or allocate the whole or part of the income of the Corpus of the Foundation fund for any of the aforesaid objects of the Foundation.

- xii To join, cooperate or amalgamate this Foundation with others having similar objects on terms and conditions as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem suitable, with regards to and in conformity with the objectives and nature of the Foundation in particular.
- xiii To accept the management of any trust, fund or endowment or any other body in which the Foundation is interested.
- xiv To enter into agreements for and on behalf of the Foundation.
- xv To use and defend all legal proceedings on behalf of the Foundation.
- xvi To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Foundation Fund or otherwise, for all or any of the purpose of this present, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowing on payment of such interest and other wise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- xvii To grant receipts, to sign and execute instruments and to endorse or discount cheques or other negotiable instruments through its accredited agents.
- xviii To make sign and execute such documents as may be necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the property and affairs of the Foundation.
- xix To appoint Committee or Sub-committee for the disposal of any business of the Foundation or for advice in any matter pertaining to the Foundation.
- xx To give aid by way of donations from the Corpus or income from the Foundation fund to other organizations or to other Trust in the state, which already exist, or to be established for the purpose mentioned above.






- xxi To employ and pay an agent (including any bank) to transact any business or to do any act, whatsoever in relation to the Foundation, including the receipt and payment of money without being liable for loss and shall be entitled to be paid all the charges and expenses incurred thereby.
- xxii To delegate all of any his/her powers to his/her nominee, in writing, who will be entitled so long as such nomination remains in force, to exercise such power or powers, in the same manner as the Trustees himself/herself could do personally.
- xxiii To apply to the International funding agencies, National funding agencies, Government, Public bodies, Urban, Local Municipal District, Corporations, Companies or other persons for and to accept grants of money, equipment, land, buildings, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the object of the Foundation and to confirm by any conditions on which such grants and other payments may be received.
- xxiv To purchase or acquire and undertake / transfer, any property assets, either wholly or partly with the liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, organizations institutions or associations with which this Foundation is authorized to amalgamate.

#### **BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

- 6. Managing Trustees if feels necessary for successful achievement of objectives of the Trust, can form a board of trustees, which could comprise of not more than 5 members. The Board can exercise all such powers with due consultation with Managing Trustees, which are as follows:
  - i The managing trustees would have full right to nominate/expel and of the members in the board.
  - ii Managing trustees can call the meeting whenever feel necessary and can decide the agenda of the meeting.

- iii The board can appoint, from time to time, such and so many employees and or such terms and conditions, as may be fit for carrying on the management and the affairs of the Foundation as also for conducting various day-to-day work, studies, investigations, researches, teachings, trainings or other works undertaken by the Foundation with due consultation with managing trustee.
- iv. Every board member will be at liberty to resign or giving one month's notice of his/her intension to do so.

#### **Caesar of Membership in Board**

- 7. A person shall cease to be a Trustee in either of the following situations:
  - i. If he/she, without informing, leave of absence, does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees, or
  - ii If he / she is requested to resign by Managing Trustees.

#### **Facilities and duties of Managing trustee**

- 8. The Managing Trustees will be entitled to receive any remuneration decided by him, furnished house, equipped office and would get reimbursement of the expenses incurred by him in connection with and in favour of the Foundation or their duties relating thereto.
- 9. Subject to the provisions of para (4) of this declaration, the present Trustees shall appoint all future trustees, the maximum number of which shall be three and minimum two. If any Trustee dies, retires become as unfit or incapable to act, the continuing or surviving trustee or Trustees will be competent to include a trustee in place which will lying vacant due to death, retirement, being unfit or incapable to act.

#### **Account of Trust**

- 10. The Trustee shall always maintain proper accounts of the Foundation, which shall be kept at the office of the Foundation.

The Board may also employ such other persons as it may think fit for carrying on the management of the Foundation and for conducting various studies, investigations, researches, etc. other works entrusted to the Foundation in connection with its objects.

Every Board member will be entitled to receive a monthly salary of such amount as may be determined by the Board.

### Chapter IV - Membership in the Board

1. - A person shall cease to be a member in case of any of the following circumstances:

(i) If he is a person who is not a citizen of India.

(ii) If he is a person who is not a resident of India.

(iii) If he is a person who is not a Hindu.

(iv) If he is a person who is not a member of the Board for a period of six months.

(v) If he is a person who is not a member of the Board for a period of six months.



10. The Board shall have the power to elect and remove members of the Board.



11. The accounting year of the Foundation shall be ending on 31<sup>st</sup> day of March of every year.
12. The Foundation Fund shall be and remain irrevocable for all times.
13. The fund of the trust would be kept in an account opened in any nationalized bank / post office and it would be operated Jointly and or individually by Managing Trustee and/or person nominated by Managing Trustees.
14. Nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorized to trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the Foundation shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any caste, religion and accordance with the provisions of the income-tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modifications thereof.

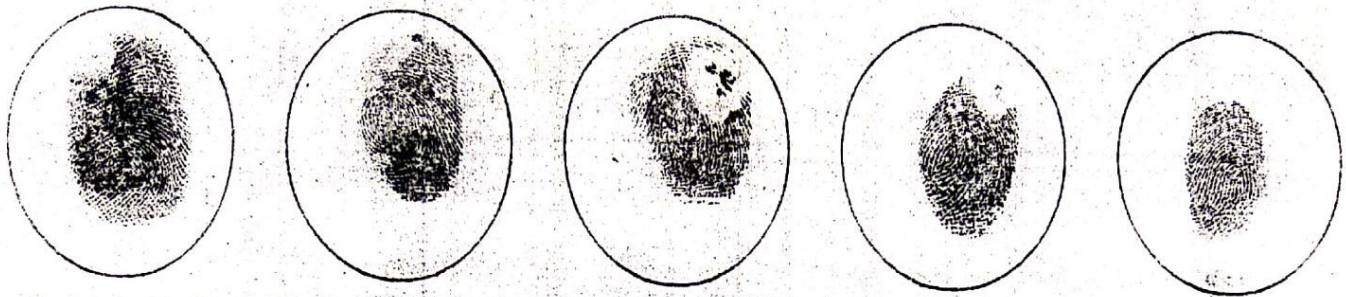

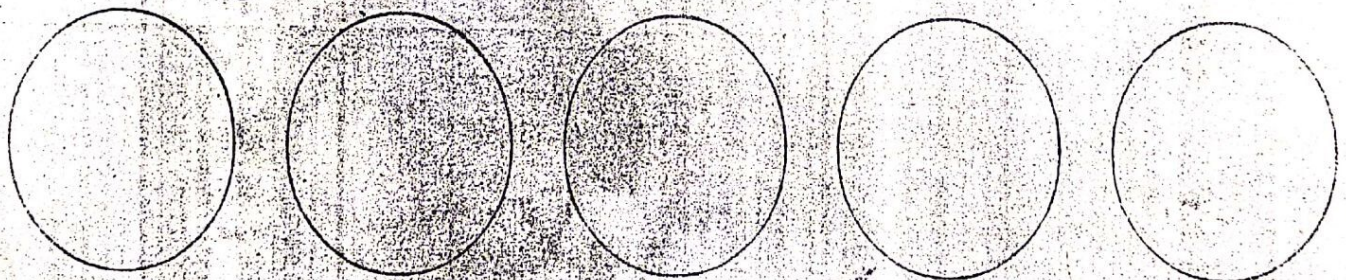

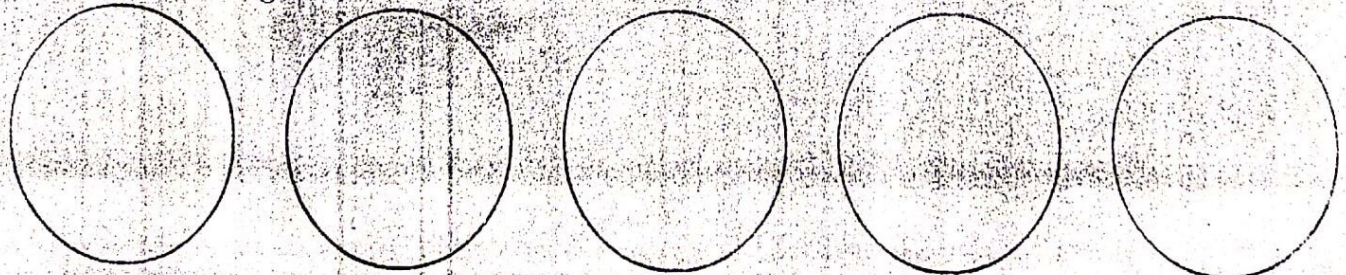
